Dear Mr. Bigwood:

This is a final response to your 10 November 2003 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for records pertaining to the two-day April 2002 coup against Venezuelan President Hugo Chavez. We processed your request in accordance with the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended, and the CIA Information Act, 50 U.S.C. § 431. Our processing included a search for records existing through 7 January 2004, the date of our acceptance letter, as described in that 7 January and our 2 February 2004 letters.

Enclosed are eight documents that can be released in segregable form with deletions made on the basis of FOIA exemptions (b)(1) and (b)(3).

Additional material was determined to be currently and properly classified and must be withheld in its entirety on the basis of FOIA exemptions (b)(1) and (b)(3). An explanation of exemptions is enclosed.

You have the right to appeal these decisions by addressing your appeal to the Agency Release Panel within 45 days from the date of this letter, in my care. Should you choose to do this, please explain the basis of your appeal.
